Details are set out below:

Entry Criteria:

Entrants must fulfil all of the points below to apply.

- Current UK Medical Student or will be applying to Graduate Medicine
- Black, Asian and Ethnic Minority
- State-funded secondary and higher level (pre-university) education for all of your education prior to university
- No parents working as medical doctors in the UK

Application:

- Mini-essay: 'Artificial Intelligence will take over the jobs of radiologists. Discuss.'
 - 500 words (not including titles and references)
 - Max 3 Figures or Tables
 - Submitted as a MS word document
 - Document should be anonymised with no author or institution details in the text
- Application close 31st January 2021, Midnight
- Award announced in early March 2021

Award:

- All applicants will be invited to attend a BAME leadership event in 2021.
- Winner will be awarded with:
 - Introduction to a UK radiologist with a defined research, educational or service improvement project
 - Costs to support presentation of work at a UK or European Conference (up to £1000)
 - Costs related to production of material (e.g. Poster printing)
 - Conference registration
 - Travel
 - Accommodation
 - Reasonable costs for food and drink
